RECOMMENDED ITEMS TO BRING

- **Snack** – Your snack is not intended as dinner, it is a bedtime snack and we highly recommend you pack a light, low-sugar option. As chaperones, you are responsible for the children during the time they should be sleeping- sugar is not recommended.
- **Personal items** – Please bring items such as hairbrush, toothbrush, toothpaste, washcloth, etc. (Please note: The Zoo has no shower facilities and most facilities have air dryers, washcloths are highly recommended).
- **Sleeping gear** - Please bring sleeping bags, pads, blankets, pillows, etc. Sleeping areas have carpeted floors. Participants may bring air mattresses (please no queen sizes or larger unless you are sharing). Participants are required to carry their luggage, so pack light! **J**
- **Cameras**- Participants are encouraged to bring cameras. However, for safety reasons, photographs are only permitted during animal demonstrations and during the morning portion of the Zoo tour.
- **Appropriate outerwear** - During the program, participants venture throughout the Zoo for **extended** periods of time. Please bring outerwear in case of bad weather (gloves, scarves, raincoat, umbrella, etc.).
