



Giraffe – Count With Us!

Use your counting skills to build a giraffe.

As the tallest animals in the world, giraffes have a clear view of their surroundings on the African savanna. With excellent eyesight, they often detect predators and threats from a greater distance than do other animals. Giraffes also use their extended reach to forage on leaves inaccessible to all other savanna dwellers except elephants.

Use whatever objects you have at home or in your outdoor spaces to build a giraffe of your own. Start by counting! 1 object = 1 foot. Use this worksheet to build your giraffe.

- 1. An adult giraffe's neck can be 6 feet long.**



2. A giraffe's tongue can be 1.5 feet long.



3. A baby giraffe can be about 10 feet tall when they are 1 year old.



4. An adult giraffe can be 18 feet tall!
