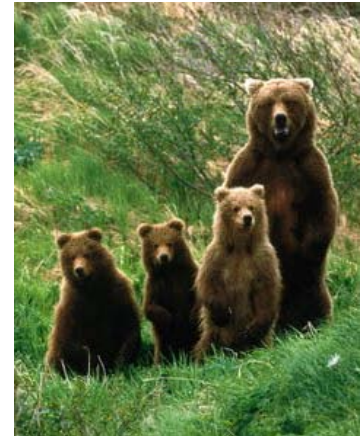
This event will take place in the Harold C. Schott Education Center at the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden. Please enter via the Erkenbrecher Entrance.
