Become a math master with a little help from live elephants.

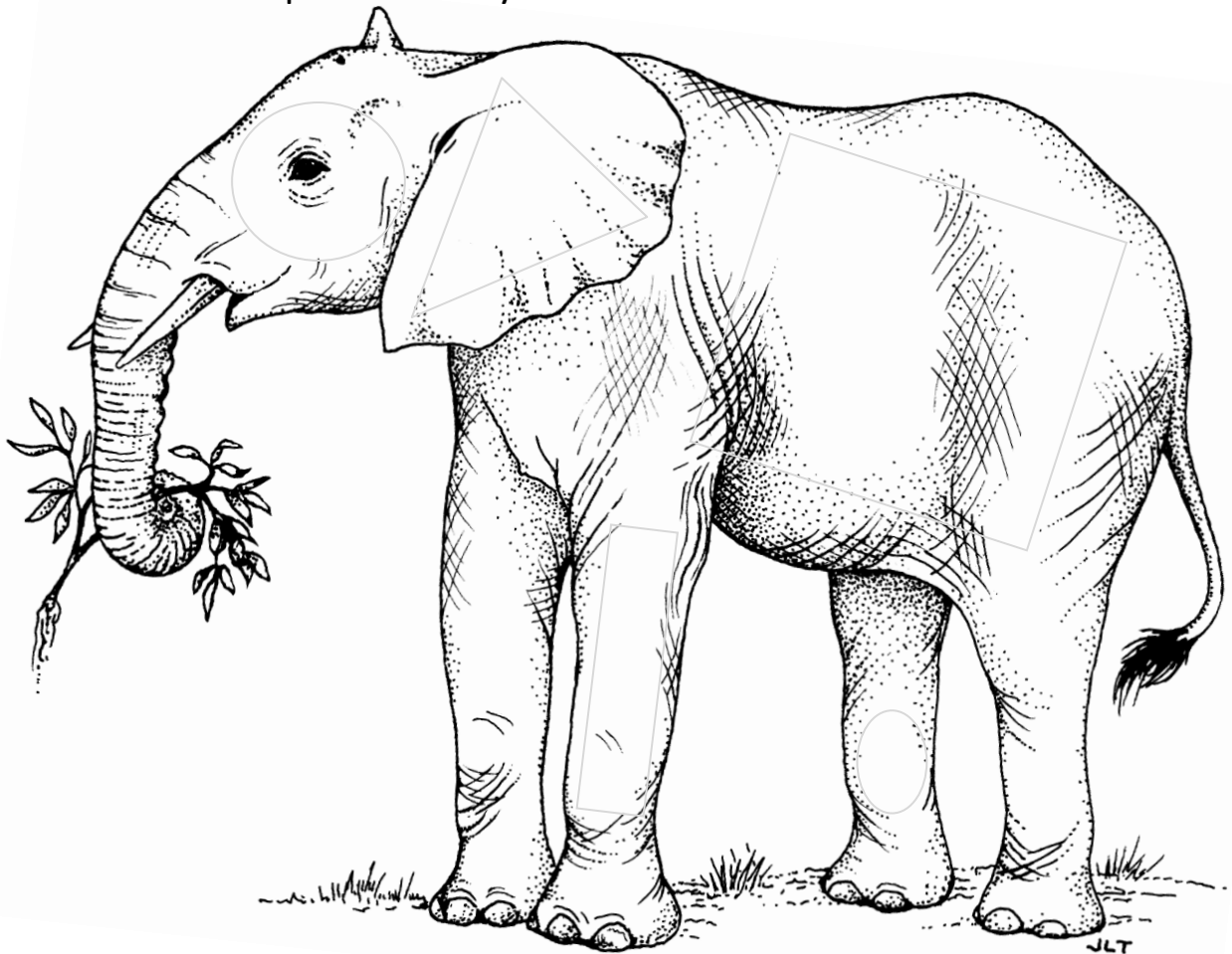
Description: Look at live elephants to learn about shapes, addition and subtraction.
