Culturally, look for shrubs that are adapted to your climate and soil, keeping in mind regional pest and disease issues. Ornamentally, large shrubs often offer excellent form, foliage, flowers, fragrance, and fruit. Some of the very best plants for fall color are large shrubs-bottlebrush buckeyes, for instance. Quite a few large shrubs have great potential to draw birds and other wildlife.

Do not underestimate the effort involved in having to annually prune shrubs to keep them "in bounds." Not only is it likely you will lose important ornamental features with pruning, it is hard work, time consuming, and can stress or introduce problems to your plants. If a site is too small to support a large shrub, find a medium or small shrub that will fit without the need of yearly maintenance. Keep in mind, however, that the greatest environmental services are achieved by planting the largest plant that can fit in a given location.

Diversity is important for the health of the ecosystem of your garden and neighborhood. If possible, try to select large shrubs that are not already commonly being used. This can greatly expand the range of insects, butterflies, birds, and wildlife that visit your garden. A little extra effort when selecting your large shrubs can result in many years of carefree enjoyment.




