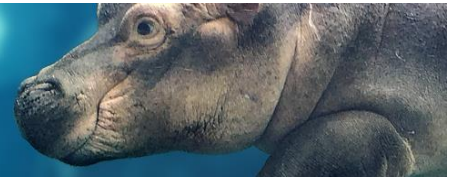




WELCOME



We want everyone to have a fun, safe, and educational Zoo visit. For the safety of your students, other visitors, and the animals, please ensure that all students under your supervision follow the following field trip rules:

Respect the animals.

Be respectfully quiet. Do not yell or throw things at animals or bang on enclosures.

Do not feed the animals. Zoo animals are on special diets and other food can be harmful for them. Do not feed local wildlife around the zoo as this can lead to injured animals and people, alters the natural behavior of animals, and may lead them to being sick.

Do not attempt to retrieve any items that fall into an exhibit. Zoo staff will retrieve for you.

All parts of the Zoo labeled Employee Only, or Restricted Access are prohibited to guests. Never cross a fence or barrier.

Respect Zoo guests.

Stay with your accompanying adults. There must be one adult chaperone for every seven students through 12th grade.

Help us ensure that all guests have a safe and enjoyable day by refraining from running, shouting, pushing, or using offensive language.

Respect the rocks, rails & roots!

Always stay on the walkways in the Zoo, behind barriers, off fences and rocks, and out of plant areas.

Help keep the Zoo clean by placing litter in the proper trash/recycling receptacles. Keep Zoo property clean and write only on appropriate surfaces.

The Zoo's staff works very hard to make the Zoo gardens beautiful for all visitors to enjoy. Please refrain from picking flowers and leaves.

Seek assistance from any Zoo staff or volunteers if a member of your group becomes lost or if you need first aid or other emergency assistance.
