Description: We can count and group animals that we see at the Zoo to help us practice our math skills.

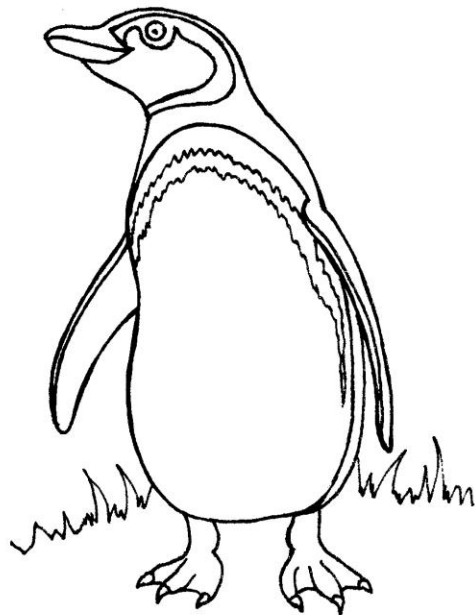
Location at Zoo: Elephant Reserve, Swan Lake, African Penguin Point **Materials:** Pencil or crayon
