# Horticulture Highlights 2024

## Your donations help us to achieve greatness!

- We expanded our Annual Trials program planting 60,000 annuals of over 600 varieties (one of the largest annual trials display gardens in the country).
- Horticulture has been very **involved in the community** this year doing work in Bond Hill, Avondale, Madisonville, and other places around the area.
  - We have planted 100 large trees along with over 4,000 perennials to create pollinator gardens in these areas.
  - Our second **urban learning garden** was put in at John P. Parker Elementary in Madisonville.
  - Irving Park in Avondale got a makeover with over 25 trees and a beautiful pollinator garden.
- Planting has been completed at the new Elephant Trek habitat and Asian Garden: a hillside of bamboo has been placed near the building as a future food source for the elephants. Eight of some of the largest trees we have planted were craned into place to provide shade for the elephants.
- The Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden applied for official arboretum status through Arbnet. • We were recognized at **Level 4**, which is the highest level awarded, because of our quality and care of our collections, educational programs, and innovative tree research at CREW.
- Our Plant for Pollinator Kits were a big hit! We now have over 3,500 registered P4P gardens.
- We had another successful year of providing native plants to home gardeners through our Bowyer Farm plant sales.
  - Most Popular Spring Plant: Virginia Bluebells, in full display in April with sky blue flowers.
  - Most Popular Fall Plant: Cardinal Flower, with vibrant spires of pure, bright red flowers that attracts bees, butterflies, and ruby throated hummingbirds.
