
IAM SO EXCITED!

ENTER THE ZOO



When we enter the Zoo, we will follow signs to Roo Valley.

WALKING DOWN

ENTERING ROO VALLEY



Once we get to the entrance, there will be two sets of doors for me to go through. I will make sure to only open one door at a time. Once one door is open, I will wait until it is closed to open the other door.

INSIDE ROO VALLEY



I will try to use a quiet voice so that I don't scare the Kangaroos.

I will also stay on the path.

CURIOUS KANGAROOS



Some of the Kangaroos may be curious and come close to me. So that we both stay safe, I will not touch the Kangaroos. If they are getting too close, I will move back.


HOPPING KANGAROOS

LITTLE BLUE PENGUINS








If I want to, I can also see the Penguins in their habitat by going through their door.

NEED A BREAK




If I am tired, I can sit down on this bench and rest until I am ready to leave Roo Valley.
