


As Zoofari guests explored the Zoo, they came upon excitement at every turn...

Zoofari guests had exclusive access for a sneak peek look at Harry and Linda Fath Elephant Trek!





Guests were transported into a different world as they entered Elephant Trek through the Komminsk Family Asian Waterfall Garden. The Asian-themed landscaping throughout the habitat was designed to mimic the natural environment found in the forests of Southeast Asia and includes plants that grow there and others that are native to the Cincinnati area, such as Catalpa, but resemble those found across the world.





The herd that will call Elephant Trek home includes bull elephant Sabu, females Anak, SheRa, Jati, Mai Thai, and Schottzie, and two young males, Kabir and Sanjay.



The elephants have access to multiple inside spaces in the Farmer Family Foundation Elephant Center as well as to three outdoor yards. This flexible design allows the elephant keeper team to manage the herd as a whole or as individuals. It is also helpful during the introduction phase. Everyone was able to view elephants inside and out.
